Welcome to the lucky month of March! In March we will explore many different learning themes including the Life Cycle of the Frog, Turtle and Butterfly along with their body parts and much more!

In mathematics, we will work on the spindle box, banking game, bead stairs, numerals and counters, tens board, addition and subtraction boards as well as short and long chains. They will also work with the color bead pyramid.

In sensorial, the children will continue working on the small and large hexagon box, rectangular box and knob less cylinders, which contains many isosceles, right, scalene, and equilateral triangles, which when constructed will form squares, rectangles, parallelograms, trapezoids and rhombuses. Lastly, they will learn the trinomial cubes and geometrical solids.

In geography, the children will continue working on the map and this month the children will learn about South America Animals. In Practical Life, the children will continue to develop their fine motor skills through classroom exercises like soap grating, weaving, lacing and art project and will learn how to design their own sand jar. We look forward to all of our activities this month with the children!
