Dear Parents,

Welcome to the lovely month of February! In February we will explore many different learning themes including: The Life cycle of a Frog, Parts of a frog, action words, and sight words.

In Mathematics, the children will continue to explore numbers through objects such as: bead stairs, numerals and counters, tens board, addition, subtraction, and multiplication boards as well as short and long chains. They will also get introduced to odd and even numbers and the “exchange game.”

In Sensorial Studies, the children will continue working on the small and large hexagon box. They will also learn about color gradation and color sorting. Lastly they will learn the trinomial cube and geometrical solids.

In Geography, the children will continue working on the landforms and the flags of countries in both Asia and North America. We will also start studying the continent of South America, including its countries and their flags.

In General Science, the children will learn about the life cycle of a frog and the parts of a frog. We will do experiments on what sinks and what floats and we will also polish pennies using salt and vinegar!

In Practical Life, the children will continue to develop their fine motor skills through classroom exercises like carrot slicing, penny polishing, weaving, lacing, and art projects, etc.
